

## **Job Description for Synod Discipline Committee**

**Volunteer Position:** Member of Synod Discipline Committee

**Purpose of Position:** To serve as a member of the NEP Synod Discipline Committee

**Term of office:** 6 years

**Responsibilities and Duties:** Follow “a process of discipline governing officers, ministers of Word and Sacrament, ministers of Word and Service, congregations, and members of congregations” as outlined in Synod Constitution S11.03 and outlined process ELCA Constitution Chapter 20 “Assure due process and due protection for the accused, other parties, and this church”

**Time Required:** Varies; depends on need (“It is the intent of this church that all matters of discipline should be resolved internally to the greatest extent possible.”)

**Qualifications and Skills:**

- Must be a voting member of a Synod congregation
- Willing to assume responsibilities as outlined in the ELCA Constitution (Chapter 20)
