

DORM LIFE AGREEMENT

Northeastern Pennsylvania Synod, ELCA
November 10-12, 2017

We gather for this weekend event as people who, first and foremost, are brought together by our faith in Jesus Christ our Lord. We are called to care for each other as we live together in community during this event. We therefore agree to follow these basic rules for our life together:

1. NO alcoholic beverages or illegal substances will be allowed (neither those brought in nor those purchased on the premises).
2. Smoking is not permitted.
3. Special needs or concerns should be referred to Pastor Lauren Applegate.
4. Dorm rooms are off-limits for the opposite sex.
5. All participants must be in their assigned room by 11:30 PM and must remain there until 7:00 a.m. of the following morning. QUIET HOURS will be observed during these same hours.
6. Attendance at all sessions and meals is mandatory. In case of illness, an adult leader must be notified.
7. All accidents and injuries must be reported to an adult leader.
8. Prescription medications may be given to the designated adult leader to ensure proper distribution.
9. As good stewards that God calls us to be, we will treat the rooms with care. No decorations can be put up with tacks, nails, staples or the like on the facility property. Do not write on the walls, furniture or the facility property. Any participants who are destructive to campus property will be held financially responsible.
10. Participants are to be responsible for the care of personal items. Cross Roads and the event planners will not be held responsible for lost or stolen items. It is suggested that participants leave valuable items at home.

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11. No littering; please help to keep the facilities clean. Please leave your room the way you found it. Do not move furniture in the bedrooms.
12. As a courtesy to the event leaders and all participants, participants will not use their cell phones unless they are given permission to do so. Phones may be used during free time.

Infringement of any of these regulations will result in dismissal from this event with a phone call to the pastor and/or parent for immediate pick up and will affect consideration of the participant's attendance at future youth events sponsored by the Northeastern Pennsylvania Synod.
