The first thing a GPS needs to know is not where we are going, but, rather, where we are. If we go to a large mall, we often find a map of the layout of all the stores. It is a wonderful help, but it is important that we find the little arrow that says "you are here." Otherwise, it is of little use.

That is what the fourth step is about; taking an inventory so that you know where you are. Then, and only then, we can begin the journey to become what God created us to be.
